

Annapurna Royal Trek

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Day to Day Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu 1,300m

After a breathtaking Himalayan flight to Kathmandu, upon arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport (TIA), you will be warmly greeted by our representative who will also escort you to your Hotel. After check in and refreshment, there will be a briefing session by our tour consultant and the rest of the day is at your leisure to rest or explore the sights of the valley. Overnight at Hotel

Day 2: Kathmandu: Sightseeing and Trek Preparation Day

Second day is basically a sightseeing and Trek Preparation day. After breakfast, we embark on a guided tour to major historical, cultural and spiritual attractions of the valley which includes World Heritage Sites like the historic Durbar Square, the sacred Hindu temple of Pashupati Nath, the famous 'Monkey Temple' (Swayambunath) and Buddhists shrine (Bouddha Nath) etc. Later in the afternoon, we have a short trip discussion and introduction with our mountain guide and other team members who will accompany you. Rest of the day is at your leisure to rest and prepare for your trip ahead. Overnight at Hotel

Day 3: Drive Pokhara (823m)

We take an early morning tourist bus to Pokhara which is an enchanting city dotted by numerous lake stopping en-route for lunch. The 5 hr scenic drive includes views of mountains like Dhaulagiri, Manaslu, Machhapuchhare, five peaks of Annapurna and other Himalayan peaks. An evening stroll alongside the Lakeside city can be a thrilling experience. Overnight in a hotel.

Day 4: Pokhara to Kalikasthan (1,370m)

After a refreshing breakfast we drive to Bijayapur Khola which is a start point of our trek. We initially hike through flat paddy fields till cross over point of a river bed. From here the trail starts to ascend to Kalikasthan. Lunch will be served midway through the climb. After arriving at Kalikasthan, one can rest, read or explore the surrounding areas. Overnight at a local Mountain Lodge

Day 5: Trek Kalikasthan to Syaklung (1,730m)

After a hearty breakfast, we continue our hike to Syaklung crossing quaint villages where lifestyles have not changed for hundreds of years. Our hike takes us through beautiful rhododendron forest and along a ridge of the mountain which offers fantastic views of Annapurna and Lamjung Himal. Overnight at Mountain Lodge

Day 6: Trek Syaklung to Chisapani (1550m)

From Syaklung a Gurung village we move playing a game of hide and seek with the rhododendron and Sal forests to Chisapani. Our trail takes us through gradients of 400 m descent to a 600 m ascent before finally arriving at the top of Chisapani which offers us a breath taking views of the Himalayan Panorama. Overnight at Mountain Lodge

Day 7: Chisapani to Pokhara

Our last day on the trail begins with a hearty breakfast, after which we hike down hill to Rupatal and again

uphill 200 meters to arrive at Sundare Danda. From here it is a 15 minutes' walk down to Begnas Tal where we can enjoy an hour of boating. After this you will get transferred to Pokhara to check in at a hotel. Later one can either take rest or explore the Lake side. Overnight at hotel

Day 8: Drive Pokhara to Kathmandu

We take the early morning tourist bus or private transport to get back to Kathmandu. (Optionally, you can also consider taking a flight back to Kathmandu). The scenic route makes our long bus journey interesting. On arrival in Kathmandu, our guide will transfer you to your hotel. The rest of the day can be spent resting or last minute shopping for handicrafts. Our specialist can also offer you insights on the latest events that may be of your interest. Overnight at Hotel

Day 9: Final Departure

Your journey of multitude experiences of natural Nepal comes to an end today! Our representative will help transfer you to the airport to catch your flight back home. Or, if you are interested you can continue your trip to other exotic locales of Nepal, Tibet, Bhutan, Darjeeling or Sikkim. Simply ask us about extension programs to these incredible destinations.

Trip Cost Includes

- Food, salary, transport, insurance, for supporting crews.
