Bhotekoshi bungy jumping is the most spectacular and bravery jump. At 160m high it is Nepal's ultimate rush and one of the longest free-falls in the world. For adventure lovers, you will find many adventure activities in Nepal and among them you can't miss one of world's thrilling sports trip Bungy Jumping. You will find Nepal's first Bungy Jumping at the location close to Friendship Bridge of Nepal – Tibet Border with 160 m long free fall at deepest gorge of Bhotekoshi River of Nepal. It takes approx 3 hours' drive about 100 km from Kathmandu. The steel suspension bridge 166m length has been designed over Bhotekoshi river at an altitude of 3600 ft., with high concentration of 4x safety factor especially for Bungy Jump. The bridge has capacity of loading 4.5 tons.
