Everest flight from Kathmandu offers an unpatrolled opportunity to witness the majestic peak, including world highest peak, Mount Everest (8848.86 m). Mount Everest Flight from Nepal Overview

The Everest flight duration typically lasts around 45 to 60 minutes. Several domestic airlines in Nepal operate these mountain flights, including Buddha Air Everest flight, Yeti Air Everest flight, and Simrik Air Everest flight. Flights to Everest are usually conducted on a small aircraft, which can accommodate around 15 to 30 passengers. This aircraft is suitable for high-altitude flights and offers large windows for optimal views and to capture the photos of Everest.

The flight starts from Tribhuwan International Airport in Kathmandu and heads east towards the Everest Region. Along the flight, passengers can view a series of iconic peaks, including Langtang, Ganesh Himal, Gauri Shankar, and Melungtse, before reaching Giant Mount Everest. The aircraft usually circle around Mount Everest, allowing passengers on both sides to get a clear view of the mountain.

Beside Everest, passengers can also see other prominent peaks such as Lhotse (8516 m), Makalu (8485 m), and Cho Oyu (8188 m). The flight offers a panoramic view of the entire Everest range, showcasing the rugged, snowcapped peaks and deep valleys of the region.

Weather plays a crucial role in Everest view; a clear sky is important to have a successful flight. Flights are scheduled for early morning 6.30am first flight and 7.30am second flight when the weather is most favorable. In the case of bad weather, a flight may be delayed or cancelled, with passengers usually given the option to reschedule or receive a refund after the deduction of transportation costs.

The cost of an Everest flight is between \$200 and \$250 per person. The price includes the flight and a guaranteed window seat. Flight is open the whole year, but the best time to fly to Everest is during the autumn (September to November) and spring (March to May) seasons when the weather is clear, providing the best view of the mountain.
