The Pokhara Sarangkot, a popular one-day hiking hill station located about 11km west of Pokhara. Sarangkot is a popular hill station with over 20 panoramic views of the Himalayas, including the Annapurna, Dhaulagiri, Machhapuchhre (Mt. Fishtail) and you can also see the Pokhara valley and Fewa Lake. Hiking to Sarangkot provides spectacular sunrise and sunset views popular for visitors looking to experience the natural beauty of Nepal up close.

One Day Pokhara Sarangkot Hiking Overview

The trek from Pokhara to Sarangkot is approximately 5km long, usually takes about 3 hours. Pokhara hiking route is steep and winding, making it moderately challenging, but hike worth the view of terraced fields, green forest and amazing Annapurna range view from Sarangkot and also offers paragliding.

Sarangkot is mostly famous for its sunrise views. Many hikers start early morning to reach the summit before dawn, where they can watch the first rays of sun reflecting golden color to the towering peaks.

Besides hiking, Sarangkot is known for adventure sports like paragliding and zip-line. Paragliding from Sarangkot offers a bird eye view of Himalayas and valley view below, while the zip line here is one of the fastest and longest in the world.

Best time for Sarangkot hike is during Autumn (September to November) and spring (March to May). This month offers clear skies and pleasant hiking weather, enhancing the visibility of the mountains making the hike more worth it.

Anyone planning to visit Nepal's natural beauty and landscape must do activity like Sarangkot hiking a combo Nepal package, physical exercise with natural landscapes.

Day to Day Itinerary

Day 1: Early Morning to Drive Sarangkot 30 Minutes and Start Hiking 4 Hours

Early in the morning drive to Sarangkot (1700m) sometime spend till sunrise over the mountains after that hike to Sarangkot top to explore the most famous enchanting tranquil Pokhara valley, local villages and Paragliding points. After that walk head down to Fewa Lake and drive to hotel.
